

Chinese Courses

International Education College sets up a series of Chinese language skill courses and a variety of Chinese culture courses to meet the needs of Chinese language learners of all types.. Chinese language skill courses include listening, speaking, reading and writing. Chinese culture courses include language element course, language skill course, culture knowledge course and regular culture lectures.

Currently, Chinese language courses set three levels, which are elementary level, pre-intermediate level and intermediate level. Students will be divided into different classes according to their language placement test.

Meanwhile, in order to encourage students to learn Chinese, a lot of public courses are available for all the students. The credit of each course is 2.5 and the credit hour is 40. Students are free to take courses based on their language level and time arrangement.

◆ Chinese Public Courses

China Today

This course is designed to improve students' Chinese language proficiency, impart an understanding of Chinese society and culture and motivate students' interest. The course introduces topics such as Chinese geography, culture, history, international relations and development of the nation. Students will find they are inspired, challenged and provided with cultural facts throughout the learning process.

Geography and Geology of China

This course, taught in Chinese and English, mainly introduces the unique geographical and geological phenomena all over China. By visiting most of the renowned mountains and great rivers in China and all kinds of geographical and geological heritages, students will acquire large academic vocabulary through extensive reading, lectures and classroom activities. This course is the perfect combination of the three courses: "Natural Geography", "Physical Geology", and "Cultural Tourism".

Chinese Writing Course (Elementary Level)

This course is designed for students, who have learned Chinese for at least half a year, in order to nurture their basic writing ability in Chinese. This class is to train students' comprehensive ability to use the Chinese characters, vocabulary, and grammar knowledge. It teaches students how to write a self-introduction, a note for leave or short message as well as how to write essays according to drawings. E-mail, post card and diary are also included.

Chinese Writing Course (Intermediate Level)

This course is designed for students who have learned Chinese for at least one year with basic Chinese knowledge. It helps to improve students' Chinese language proficiency and cultivate their independent thinking, to solidify and enhance students' Chinese techniques. Some simple professional essay and narration about everyday life are also included.

Chinese Reading (Elementary Level) Class Two

This course is designed for students, who have learned Chinese for at least half a year. This course is to widen students' vocabulary and train their ability in reading of elementary Chinese. Through reading and analyzing various materials, students could widen their knowledge, and cultivate their logic thought and independent thinking, to solidify and enhance students' Chinese techniques.

Chinese Reading Class (Intermediate Level)

This course is designed for students, who have learned Chinese for at least one year. By reading and analyzing various materials, students could improve their Chinese language proficiency and gain more vocabulary. It helps to arouse students' interest to know china and Chinese culture.

Chinese Language (Elementary Level) Class One

This course is designed for students who will learn Chinese from the start point without any basis. Students who have learned Chinese but had forgotten can also come to attend this course. Everyday vocabulary and sentences, basic dialogues, pronunciation, Chinese characters are all referred in this course. After finishing this course, students will be able to communicate in Chinese in their daily life.

Chinese Language Course (Intermediate Level)

This course is designed for students who have learned Chinese for at least one year and want to improve themselves. Through extensive reading in Chinese, students' language proficiency will be greatly improved.

Chinese Martial Arts

Chinese Martial Arts is one of China's outstanding traditional national sports. This course is mainly talking about Wushu culture and students will be taught to do some basic exercises of Wushu. Through learning this course, students will not only master some Wushu movements, which contain Wubuquan (Five-step Boxing) and Eight Forms Taiji Quan, but also promote their understanding of Chinese Wushu culture.

Multi-culture Understanding

This course aims to promote the cultural understanding between the countries all over the world. Through the study of this course, students can correctly treat their own national culture and appreciate the other nation's culture, reduce the discomfort to study abroad. Understanding the diversity of world culture can make students learn to coexist and cooperate.
